2013 Merlot

Our Feather in Cap Merlot is the epitome of drinkability. Smooth and juicy, it is bursting with delicious plum and cherry fruit flavours, all leading to a rich yet soft finish. Its ripe, rounded character ensures that it can be equally enjoyed with or without food.

The Fruit

Grapes are sourced from selected premium vineyards around Adelaide's Fleurieu Peninsula, specifically McLaren Vale and Langhorne Creek. This combination of mediterranean and maritime climates allows us to marry power and richness with softness and elegance to deliver a style that is consistently appealing, no matter what challenges vintage may throw at us.
