Angullong is located amongst the picturesque foothills of Mount Canobolas in the high elevation, cool climate wine region of Orange, New South Wales, about 350km west of Sydney. The region's cool climate and ancient soils have combined with careful hands-on viticultural management to produce quality fruit and wines with great regional character.

GRAPE VARIETY:	Shiraz
REGION:	Orange Region, NSW
WINEMAKING:	The fruit was fermented separately in stainless steel fermenters, with twice daily pump-overs to extract colour and flavour. The parcels were then matured in French Oak prior to blending.
COLOUR:	Deep blackish purple / ruby red.
AROMA:	Rich and concentrated aromas of blackberry, spice, cracked pepper, liquorice and cigar box.
PALATE:	Generous ripe blackberry and plum flavours with complex spice and long velvety tannins.
WINE ANALYSIS:	Alc/vol: 13.5%
ADDITIVES	Made using traditional methods. Some traces of egg products may remain. Preservative 220 added.
PEAK DRINKING:	2014 to 2018
FOOD MATCHES:	Char-grilled meat, game, casseroles, cheese.
AWARDS:	Gold Medal, 2014 Orange Wine Show. Gold Medal, 2015 Royal Sydney Wine Show. 2014 NSW Top Wine, NSW Wine Awards.
