BLEND Pinot Noir

COLOUR
Pale vibrant red/garment tones

AROMATICS

Intensely perfumed nose, aromas of wild thyme with hints of floral lavender flow into dark cherry, raspberry, and spices

PALATE

The palate is tightly wound with tension and great length. Balanced acidity and whole bunch crunch bring together a complex wine filled with red fruits, ample spice, and earthy characteristics.

AGEING POTENTIAL 10 + years.

WINEMAKING

Three Several different batches of Pinot from Warramunda Estate made up this blend: different methods were used for each batch including destemmed fruit with various ratios of whole bunch. The final blend is approximately 20% whole bunch and 80% whole berry. All ferments were completed with wild yeast minimal intervention and daily punch downs.

VINEYARD NOTES

Good rainfall during winter through to an early warm Spring. Followed by daily caried maximum temperatures throughout till a hot and dry December. Massive dump of rain during January, followed by a cool growing season that delayed picking until late February and early March.
